Proof of your Right to Study in the UK – Required Documentation

As part of your enrolment at Bath Spa University we must check your right to study in the UK before you can start your course. This involves checking your original documents and retaining copies where required, as per the University's responsibilities to UKVI.

It is your responsibility as a student subject to immigration control to provide us with valid right to study documentation, and failure to do so will result in you being unable to enrol on your course.

Please bring your original documents to be checked. Photocopies and scans of passports, BRPs and visas cannot be accepted.

There are many different UK immigration categories that permit study therefore this is not an exhaustive list. If you are in any doubt, please bring with you your passport, BRP / visa (if you have one) and any documentation from the UKVI relevant to your UK immigration status. If you have a digital immigration status rather than a physical BRP / visa, please bring along your [Gov.uk generated share code](#).

Please note that if you commence your studies at BSU on a non-Student route visa which does not cover the full length of your course, you must either extend this visa before it expires or apply for a Student Route visa before your current visa expires.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student visa sponsored by Bath Spa University (Biometric Residence Permit or Digital Immigration Status). • Entry Clearance Vignette sticker where applicable (BSU Sponsor Licence Number: JVACU29U9). • Valid passport. • Please also bring your UKVI decision letter which confirms that your visa application was successful and shows where your BRP has been delivered. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you used BSU’s Alternative Collection Location (2HE982) when you submitted your visa application, your BRP will be delivered to the University, and you can collect it from Newton Park campus during scheduled collection periods. • If you collected your BRP from a local post office, you will need to bring your BRP to Newton Park campus so that we can check and take a copy of your BRP. • EEA / Swiss nationals who use the ‘UK Immigration: ID Check’ app will be issued a digital immigration status and therefore will not receive a BRP or entry clearance vignette. • If you have been issued a digital immigration status, please provide us with a share code to prove your Right to Study. Share codes can be generated on Gov.uk - View and prove your immigration status: get a share code - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk). Please note that we cannot accept a right to work or right to rent share code. • The entry clearance vignette is the sticker in your passport which allows you to enter the UK within a 90-day period. You must arrive in the UK between the dates stated on your vignette. • If you entered the UK via an eGate and / or did not get your passport stamped by a UK Border Force official upon entry, please provide us with proof of your entry to the UK (e.g. flight boarding pass).

If you have been issued a digital immigration status, please provide us with a share code to prove your Right to Study.
