

# Professional Masters Programme

## Learning & Knowledge Technology Award Routes

### 60 credits- First stage for all Awards

- Any validated LKT modules lead to a PG Cert LKT award

Credit for LKT professional experience and other previous HE courses or equivalent (APL) – **only available** for PG Dip and MA/MTeach qualifications. The Certified Naace Professional (CNP) scheme Certificate gains 60 level 7 credits and can be used towards both the PG Dip, MA & MTeach awards.

### 60 credits – Second stage PG Dip LKT Award

OR

### 30 credits – Second stage towards the final Master's LKT Award.

- Award specific modules:
  - Learning & Knowledge Technology (30 credit taught or online module)
- Generic modules linked to the Award:
  - Independent Study Module (30 credit flexible supervision module)
  - Work-based Action Enquiry Module (30 credit – as above)

PG Diploma

### 30 credits – Compulsory Second Stage for the Master's in LKT

#### Research and the Professional - Part 1 (15 credit flexible module)

Includes gaining an understanding of research methodologies

#### Research and the Professional - Part 2\* (15 credit flexible module)

\*Includes project design and proposal for continuation to the dissertation final stage for a Master's Award

### 60 credits – Final Stage Master's Award in LKT

#### Master's Research Project or Cognate

The research project must reflect the subject or area of specialism, i.e. must be a project linked to the Award in Learning and Knowledge Technology.

Progression onto an MPhil or PhD research degree in LKT is available via consultation with your Award Leader and/or the Head of Research.
