What is Bath Spa Counts?


This booklet contains a snapshot of Bath Spa's staff and student data for the year 2019/20.



Comparator data is taken from the Higher Education Statistics Agency (HESA) and includes data from: Chichester, Falmouth, Gloucestershire, Goldsmiths, Lincoln, Oxford Brookes, and Winchester Universities. Sector data and student data is also taken from HESA.

STAFF GENDER DATA

All Staff Gender






At Bath Spa University (BSU) in the year 2019/20, **57.3%** of staff identified as women, **42.2%** as men, and **0.5%** as 'other'.


Our comparator group was 55.5% women, and for all Universities it was 54.1%

Senior Staff Gender

49.5% of our senior staff identified as women.
43.3% of our comparator group senior staff identified as women, and 42% of the sector.




Professors Gender



49.8% of our professorial staff identified as women.
36.6% of our comparator group professorial staff identified as women, and
27.8% of the sector.

Academic and Professional Services Gender




Of our academic staff, **53.7%** identified as women
Of our senior Academic Staff, **51.4%** identified as women.

Of our professional services staff, 61.2% identified as women. Of our senior Professional Services staff, 40% identified as women.

Note: Whilst the percentage for senior Professional Services staff was low, it was taken from only 10 staff members in total.

Gender Pay Gap



The mean gender pay gap at BSU was 11.2% or £2.28 per hour.


The median pay gap was 18.6% or £4.00 per hour.

Last year, these figures were 21.8% and 13.1% respectively.

The distribution of staff based on their hourly pay shows that the lower quartile is 69% women; the lower mid quartile is 60.8% women; the upper mid quartile is 57.8% women; and the upper quartile is 48% women.

STAFF ETHNICITY DATA

All Staff Ethnicity




6.2% of BSU staff identified as Black, Asian, mixed race, or other minority ethnicity (shortened to 'BAME'). 86.2% of BSU staff identified as White, and 7.6% of BSU staff have chosen not to tell us their ethnicity.

Our comparator group was 13% BAME staff, and the sector was 14.3% BAME staff.

7.2% of Academic Staff and 5.2% of Professional Services Staff at BSU identified as BAME.


Senior Staff Ethnicity

Of our comparator group, 7.2% of senior staff identified as BAME and for the sector this was 6.7%


STAFF DISABILITY DATA

All Staff Disability



8.6% of BSU staff identified themselves as having a disability. For our comparator group, this figure was 6.8% of staff, and for all Universities this was 5.5%


Senior Staff Disability



4% of our Senior Staff identified as having a disability. For our comparator group, this figure was 2.5% of senior staff, and for the sector it was 3.7%


STAFF AGE DATA

All Staff Age




The percentage of staff under the age of 40 was generally lower than our comparator group and the sector. In the 46-50 bracket, we had more staff than the comparator group and the sector.

Senior Staff Age




For senior staff, percentages of staff in each age range was generally in line with our comparator group and the sector. In comparison to benchmarking groups, we were slightly overrepresented in the 46-50 bracket and underrepresented in the 56-60 bracket.

ALL STAFF SEXUALITY DATA




73.1% of staff identified as heterosexual, 4.6% as lesbian, gay, or bisexual, and 0.5% as 'other'. 21.9% did not inform us of their sexuality. In our comparator group, 5.3% of staff identified as LGB or other, 2.4% of South West Universities, and 3.5% of staff at all Universities.


STAFF RELIGION & BELIEF DATA



21.6% of staff identified as Christian, 6.8% as another religion, 48.4% had no religion, and 22.8% did not inform us of their belief. In our comparator group, 22.1% of staff were Christian and 6.5% another religion. At all Universities 17.6% of staff were Christian and 5.8% another religion.


STUDENT GENDER DATA






In the academic year 2019/20, Bath Spa had just under 8,500 students. Of these, 68.7% of students identified as women, 31.2% men, and 0.1% as 'other'. Our comparator group's students were 65.8% women, and for all Universities 56.9% of students identified as women.

STUDENT DOMICILE DATA




6.4% of BSU students are international. Our comparator group was 12.2% international, and the sector was 22% international.

UK STUDENT ETHNICITY DATA



At BSU, 89.6% of UK domiciled (non-international) students identified themselves as White, 2.3% as Black, 2.9% as Asian, 3.7% identified as mixed race, 1.1% as another ethnicity, and 0.4% did not tell us their ethnicity. Our comparator group was 16% BAME students, at Universities in the South West students were 13.8% BAME, and for all Universities 23.6% were BAME.

STUDENT DISABILITY DATA



At BSU, 23.1% of students have told us that they have a disability. At our comparator group, 21% of students were known to have a disability, and for all Universities it was 14.6% of students.

11.4% of BSU students received DSA, whilst for the sector 7% of students were receiving DSA.
