- A formal letter of application outlining:
 - How you would use your time at Bath Artists' Studios
 - Why it would be significant at this point in your career
 - Please also state how you intend to support yourself financially during the studio placement.
- Four images of your work with captions (jpeg format or PDF image sheet) (if applicable)
- Link to website (if applicable)

Don't forget to ensure you provide full contact details – all applicants must be contactable by phone/email between the submission and interview dates. Also please note that the successful applicant will be asked to take part in a case study at the end of their studio residency.
