

THE FORUM

A designated Grade II* listed building that was built as an art deco cinema and is now home to our graduation ceremonies.



GUILDHALL

Is an 18th-century municipal building in central Bath and the collection point for your graduation gowns.



ROYAL VICTORIA PARK

Explore these beautiful Victorian parklands with gardens to explore, opened by Queen Victoria in 1830.



THE ROMAN BATHS

This site was once one of the great religious spas of the ancient world, it is now one of the finest historic sites in Northern Europe.



PULTNEY BRIDGE

Built in the 18th century, this scenic bridge is lined with shops and cafés.



THE CIRCUS

A short walk from the Royal Crescent is the Circus. The Circus is a great place to take in the atmosphere of the city of Bath.



BATH ABBEY

At the centre of historic Bath, this medieval place of worship is filled with memorials and stained glass.



THE ROYAL CRESCENT

These Grade I listed Georgian terraced town houses are arranged around a perfect lawn overlooking Royal Victoria Park.



SYDNEY GARDENS

Opened in 1795 and once a favourite spot of Jane Austen. Sydney Gardens is one of Britain's best remaining Georgian Pleasure Gardens.
