



The Writing Award 2025/2026

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The successful recipient of The Writing Award is subject to a number of conditions, detailed below.

- The recipient must be a current registered student at the beginning of their academic year if full time or at the beginning of either academic year if part time, AND be accepted on to one of the following courses:
 - MA Creative Writing
 - MA Nature and Travel Writing
 - MA Scriptwriting
 - MA Writing for Young People.
- Students studying at Bath Spa University's [Educational Partner](#) institutes are not eligible for this Award.
- Communication about the Award, including any Award offer, will be via the recipient's Bath Spa University email address.
- The Award is not considered confirmed until the recipient has provided a digital or hand-written letter addressed to the Donors accepting the Award and expressing their gratitude for the Award. The recipient has 28 days from the date of the Award offer being made to comply with these requirements. If the recipient does not comply within 28 days, Bath Spa University reserves the right to withdraw the offer of the Award.
- Payment of the Award will be made to the recipient only via the bank details they have registered in their Bath Spa University AppHub account.
- If, by reason of any emergency or other circumstance, the recipient is unable to complete their course, they will be required to refund all or part of the Award as may be considered reasonable in all the circumstances.
- The Recipient may be requested to report back about the Award prior to completing their course. This information will be used in literature to promote the value of the Award and provide feedback to those who support the Award and the University.
- Recipients may be publicised on the University website and in the media; recipients will be expected to provide appropriate feedback (e.g. reports, blogs, pictures and/or videos) to support this.

- Recipients may be interviewed by the press office and/or be invited to attend events with donors who support awards at BSU, partners in the project, other successful award recipients and the wider University community, allowing discussion about the projects that have been carried out. Reasonable efforts must be made to attend these events and to meet with the donor.
- Recognition of the award should be made wherever possible. Wording such as 'Supported by The Bath Spa University Writing Award sponsored by Jack and Audrey Ladevèze' would suffice, but please run the wording by the Scholarships and Bursaries Coordinator.
